


## **Installation Instructions Indicator Warning Light**



Warning: This instrument is for use on Mercury / Mariner Outboards that are equipped for Two Function warning panels only. This instrument provides visual warning only.

## Light Functions

- Temp light warns of temperature increase.
- Oil light warns of low oil reservoir levels.

<u>CAUTION:</u> Disconnect the battery during installation. Tighten nuts on the back clamp only slightly more than you can tighten with your fingers. Six **inch-pounds** of torque is sufficient. Over tightening could result in damage to the instrument and may void the warranty.

1. Cut a 2 1/16" diameter hole in the dash and mount the gauge with the back clamp supplied.

- 2. Consult your engine manual for proper wiring harness connections to your warning indicator. Connect wiring of the indicator as follows:
- Purple 12V Positive (+) to your ignition switch
- Purple/White 12V Positive (+) to your lighting circuit
- Black To Ground (-)
- Tan/Black To Engine temperature sensor
- Tan/White To Oil level sensor

**NOTE:** To change light bulbs, twist the black socket assembly one-eighth turn counter clockwise until it pops out. The bulb pulls straight out of socket assembly. It is a *GE* No. 161 instrument lamp.
